


Bass of Ontario

These fish are aggressive and will strike a variety of presentations, including live bait (worms, minnows, leeches) and a variety of artificial lures (spinners, spoons, crakbaits, soft plastics).

Rock bass


Although "bass" is used in its common name, the rock bass is more commonly associated with panfish than with largemouth and smallmouth bass.



Smallmouth bass

The smallmouth bass prefers cooler waters than the largemouth and is more common in central and northern Ontario.

Largemouth bass

The largemouth bass generally prefers the warmer, shallower waters of southern Ontario.
